##### RESTRAINTS:

##### APPLICATION TABLE:

RotStop Timber Preservative can be applied either by direct injection into predrilled holes or injection into an externally applied bandage system\*.

#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

RotStop Timber Preservative is effective in controlling surface mould, algae and fungi. It will also at the insecticide rate help control common wood borers and termites.

RotStop Timber Preservative is supplied ready for use for in-situ, remedial/preventative treatment as per application table.

#### PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEA AND ENVIRONMENT:

Do not contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in original closed container in a dry, cool, well ventilated area. Do not store for long periods in direct sunlight. **DO NOT** use the container for any other purpose. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Dispose of rinsings in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose, clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots.

Break, crush or puncture and bury containers in a local authority landfill.

If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.
